- The RMH of Cleveland, Inc. supports families whose children receive treatment at area medical centers by providing home-like environment and essential resources and services. The House has 37 bedrooms and accommodates local families as well as families from around the world. As an independent non-profit organization, the House relies upon volunteers from the community to help meet the many needs of the families that stay there. One such volunteer area is the Family Meal program. Dinners are scheduled daily. Breakfasts/brunch and lunch meals are scheduled on weekends and holidays. - Volunteer Opportunity:
- Breakfast will consist of heat and serve items – frozen sausage patties, potatoes, pancakes and sometimes cinnamon buns – plus coffee, tea and milk. The meal will be served buffet style on disposable dinnerware and food should be ready by 10:00 AM. The number of families participating varies but we will need to prepare food for 50 people. After cooking, volunteers are welcome to stay to eat and visit with the families. Besides food prep, our group will be also be responsible for clean up (i.e. wiping down counters, covering/labeling leftovers, sweeping and taking out the garbage).
- A short house tour and orientation of the kitchen will be provided for first time visitors/volunteers.
